Board Members present: Jeff Pauly, Brooke Drassal-Creighton, Travis Grover, John Moder and Dava Scribner. Mary Jo Lehmann, Michael Schreck and Carly Christenson were excused from the meeting. President, Jeff Pauly called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM.

New and re-elected Board members were welcomed. Minutes from the the prior

Board Meeting were presented to the Board Members that were present. A current Income and Expense Report was also presented. Dava Scribner agreed to contact Susie Reed in regards to NCHA Day weekend to find out if South Dakota had any intentions of hosting the show. Dava Scribner would also contact the NCHA to clarify the rules for NCHA Day weekend.

Jeff Pauly agreed to look into acquiring a "cattle handler" and someone to "work" the loping area ground for the March Cutting. Jeff Pauly will also check into the sand situation for the cutting.

Brooke Drassal-Creighton reported that the Banquet facility at the Timberlake was no longer an option for the Banquet. The members authorized Brooke Drassal-Creighton to make a determination as to where the Banquet would be held.

It was decided that the association should purchase some gates that would go with the panels to make moving cattle around at the cuttings easier. Jeff Pauly agreed to handle this project.

It was decided to make the three MCHA produced Owatonna Cuttings 500 added and keep the balance of the cuttings at 299 added.

Brooke Drassal-Creighton offered to look into awards for the Owatonna series of cuttings.

The Board informed John Moder that they were in favor of having the veterans participate at all or any of the shows.

The Board discussed having a "Code of Conduct" to follow. The board decided to

approve the three Owatonna Cuttings in June produced by JP Bell.

Jeff Pauly was voted in as President and Mary Jo Lehmann as Vice-President.
